**Staff Reports**

**A. Field Manager**

Mr. Grasso briefly discussed items included in his report previously forwarded to the Board such as monitoring the construction at the daycare center, sidewalk repair issues and vehicle vandalism in Ashmonte.

On MOTION by Mr. Paradiso seconded by Mr. Cascio with all in favor the Valley Crest estimate for a Class Two three-year tree pruning program in the amount of not to exceed \$7,500 was approved.

Ms. Intini also requested to include the Utility Court, including painting the shuffleboard court on it, on the next workshop agenda.
